Free Lunch Procedures: Albany Unified students, who were free or reduced last year, keep their approved status until October 9, 2014. If returning students do not submit a new application and are not given approval for free or reduced status, they will automatically revert back to paid status on October 10, 2014. New students need to submit an application no matter what their status was in their last district. You can get an application through the AUSD website, www.ausdk12.org, in the Food Services section. Food Services will contact you by email or phone once you are approved. For questions regarding food service issues, call 510-558-2608 or 510-558-2607.

Lunch: If you are purchasing a lunch for your child with check or cash, please fill out an envelope on the counter in the office. If you would like to purchase lunches with a debit or credit card, please go online to the "My School Bucks" payment system on the district website. Lunches (including milk) are \$3.75 per day and must be pre-paid. You may purchase any amount you wish. The total will continue to roll over until it's used up. You may purchase milk for .50 for your child to use when she/he brings a home lunch. Please send your child with a snack daily whether they are having school lunch or home lunch.
